11.	Students are to respect all adult leaders and follow their instructions. All adults (members of HLC staff & leadership team, church leadership teams,	and adult volunteers) are in
12.	places of authority over all students. HLC staff and volunteers have been trained to facilitate each activity.  Campers (adults & students) must attend all scheduled events. If your group is at an activity, you must be with them. There are no exceptions to this	unless the camper (adult &
13.	student) is injured or sick and are at the HLC camp office, the HLC Health Center, or at the hospital.  Campers (adults & students) MUST be in the bunkhouse by designated camp curfew. Curfew is for the safety and well-being of campers and staff.	
14. 15.	Students are not allowed to leave Highland Lakes Camp without proper parental written authorization and approval of HLC Administrative Staff. Campers (adults & students) are not permitted to bring pets on Highland Lakes Camp property or into any Highland Lakes Camp building. Leave all	pets at home. Seeing eye

- and service dogs on a leash and under immediate control of the owner are accepted.

  Campers (adults & students) and/or church group leadership will be held financially responsible for any property damages that occur during their stay at HLC. Campers should
- refrain from writing on furniture or walls. Do not use duct tape to affix signs to doors or walls. For your safety, guests are not allowed on any HLC "Restricted" property areas.
- For the safety of campers (adults & students) who participate in the Hexapod Adventure and/or Zip Line, the following guidelines are to be followed:

  - Participants <u>must</u> wear closed-toe shoes and no wind shorts or loose-fit clothing. Participants with shoulder length hair or longer must put their hair in a ponytail or braid.
