## Rates & Amenities

Rates Effective: September 1, 2024 - August 31, 2025.

### Meals

- \$11.00 per person per meal
- Catering at \$2.00 per person per meal and Delivery at \$0.50 per person per meal available on request.

### Lodging Rates

Rates are per person, per night unless otherwise stated. Meals not included.

#### Bunk House: \$38

- Bunk Room Style w/Bunk beds
- Bring your own twin size bedding
- Restrooms in the building
- Air Conditioning / Heating

#### Private Rooms: \$68 single occupancy, \$48 per person per night for multiple occupancy

- 1 Queen Bed & 1 Twin Bed or 1 Queen Bed & 1 Twin Bunk Bed
- Linens & towels provided
- Private Bath
- Air Conditioning / Heating

#### Kilburn Cottage: \$140 per night; \$50 cleaning fee

- 1 King Bed & 1 Queen Bed
- Linens & towels provided
- Kitchenette and dining area
- Private bath
- Air Conditioning / Heating

#### The Upper Room: \$200 per night; \$50 cleaning fee

- Main Bedroom: 1 Queen Bed & 1 Bunk Bed with Double bottom & Twin top
- Bunk Room: 1 Queen Bed & 3 Bunk Beds
- Linens & towels provided
- Kitchen and dining area
- Each sleeping area has private bathroom
- Air Conditioning / Heating
- Balcony porch

#### RV Park: \$50 per night

- Full hookup with water, sewer, electricity (30 or 50 amp circuits)
- Bath house available

#### Campus Day Use Fee: \$15

- Each individual attending an event on the Highland Lakes Baptist Encampment grounds but is not paying for HLBE lodging or recreational activities based on per person fees will be responsible to pay a Guest Fee of \$15 per day he / she is on the grounds plus meals.

### Reservations

Reservations are confirmed through a signed contract and paid deposit. A 20% nonrefundable deposit and signed contract must be returned within one month of date contract issued. This signed contract commits to pay for 90% of the expected number of guests. Guaranteed minimum is due upon arrival at Check-in. Final payment due 10 days from final issued invoice. All buildings are subject to Fire Marshal capacities.

### Conference Rooms / Meeting Options

The listed locations are reserved on first-requested/contracted basis.

#### Miles Auditorium: \$800 per day

- Holds up to 1,100.
- Permanent stage and sound booth. Sound, lighting, projection systems included. Requires HLBE technicians to operate - available 8:30am-10:30pm.

#### Miles Foyer: \$200 per day

- Holds up to 125

#### Providence Tabernacle: \$350 per day

- Holds up to 350
- Permanent stage and sound booth. Sound, lighting, projection systems included. Requires HLBE technicians to operate - available 8:30am-10:30pm.

#### Conference Center: \$350 per day

- Holds up to 350
- Mobile stage

#### Conference Center Breakout Rooms: \$30 each per day

- 5 rooms hold up to 50 and 1 holds up to 75

#### Independence Chapel: \$50 per day

- Holds up to 40

#### Bunkhouse Meeting Room: \$50 per day

- Complimentary if overnight bunkhouse lodging is 50% full.
- Additional Technical set up: \$30

#### Highland Inn Meeting Room: \$150 per day

- Holds up to 75
- Mounted 70" TV

### Outdoor Venues:

#### Prayer Garden: \$75 per hour

- Holds up to 120

#### Mudd: \$75 per hour

- Holds up to 100
- Permanent Stage

## Amenities and Recreation Options

All recreational activities must be submitted to HLC Administration for approval 3 weeks prior to event on the Set-up Check List.

### Amenities Without Fees:

Archery Range, Axe Throwing, Baseball Fields, Basketball Courts, Sand Volleyball Pits, Soccer Field, Disc Golf, GaGa Ball, Human Foosball, Cornhole, Hiking Trail, Fishing (bring own equipment & bait), 9 Square, Crossnet, Pickleball, Polypong

Staffing to include: Certified Lifeguards, Certified Hexapod Facilitators, Medical Health Technicians, Trained Challenge Course Facilitators

### Amenities for an ADDITIONAL FEE with advance reservation:

**WATER ACTIVITIES:** Lake activities are subject to weather conditions and safe water level/conditions. Available May - September.

**Ski Boat: \$15 per person per hour, \$25 per person for 2 hours**

- Minimum 16 people
- Used to pull 8-passenger banana water sled
- Price includes: boat driver, fuel, lifejackets, and lifeguards

**\*Swim Pond: : \$15 per person for 2 hours**

- Minimum 16 people
- Floating obstacle course, slides
- Stand-up paddle boards & 2 person kayak
- HLBE lifeguards must be on duty at all times. Participants must wear a provided lifejacket.

\* With the addition of the swim pond, some activities will be adjusted for the 2024 summer season.

**Swimming Pool: \$150 per hour per group**

- HLBE lifeguards must be on duty at all times.

Rental groups are limited to a **maximum of 2 hours per day** for scheduled activities at either the pool or waterfront.

**HEXAPOD:** 45 element self-guided High Ropes Course

- Minimum 20 people
- Must be at least 10 years old; 275lb weight limit

**Hexapod - Full Course with Zip line: \$15 per person, 1 hour session**

**Hexapod - Elements Only: \$12.50 per person, 1 hour session**

**Hexapod - Zip Only: \$12.50 per person, 1 hour session**

**Rockwall: \$10 per person, 1 hour session**

### **OTHER:**

**BB Gun Range: \$30 per hour per group**

- Minimum 10 people

**Archer's Quest: \$50 per hour per group**

- Minimum 10 people

**Gellyball: \$10 per person per hour or \$200 for a group of 20 or more per hour**

- Minimum 10 people
- Includes safety gear, Blaster, and hopper of Gellyballs

**Archery and Axe Throwing** are free amenities, but they have to be scheduled.

**CAMPFIRE:** \$50 for 1 hour session. Subject to Travis County fire ban.

**SILENT DISCO:** \$5 per headphone, \$25 per transmitter for 2 hour session

- Minimum - 50 headphones; Maximum - 700 headphones
- Provide your own music source for 3 transmitters
- DJ available at \$50 per hour
